## 44™ ANNUAL STATEN ISLAND SINGLES CLASSIC RULES

- The 44<sup>th</sup> Annual Staten Island Singles Classic will take place Saturday April 2 thru April 23, 2022 at Rab's Country Lanes 1600 Hylan Boulevard Staten Island, New York 10305. Qualifying Rounds will take place on 4/2, 4/9, and 4/10/2022. Entries close: Sunday April 10, 2022 at 2:45 PM. The Finals will take place on Saturday April 23, 2022 at 1:00 PM.
- Open to all men and women with a USBC certified averaged including PBA members, except any PBA member who has won a PBA title within last 10 years.
- 3. All PBA members will bowl scratch, regardless of league average.
- 4. Bowlers must use **highest** USBC average of last 2 years (2019-2021), if no average, bowl scratch.
- 5. If 2021-2022 average, as of April 3<sup>rd</sup>, is **10 pins higher** bowler must use that average, minimum 21 games.
- 6. Youth league averages **are not** accepted.
- 7. Sport / Challenge League averages will be converted using USBC conversion chart.
- 8. Bowlers found to be reporting a false average will be subject to disqualification or rerating.
- 9. Handicap based 60% of 225 average.
- 10. For handicapping purposes, the minimum average is 150.
- 11. Finals will consist of 24 bowlers, including at least **one female**, **one senior (50+)**, **8 squad leaders**, and then next **14 highest scores**.
- 12. In the event of a tie for advancement into the finals, a one game roll-off will determine the winner.
- 13. Prizes awarded 1:10. All finalists (24) guaranteed prize money.
- 14. Handicap carried throughout finals.
- 15. **Top 8** series receive a bye in Finals, if a tie for 8<sup>th</sup> spot, high scratch game will break tie.
- 16. Squads must have a minimum of 6 bowlers to qualify for a guarantee of squad leader.
- 17. If a squad does not have 6 bowlers minimum, squad will bowl, and tournament will guarantee less than 12 squad leaders in finals. 24 bowlers will still make the finals based on score.
- 18. Bowlers who make finals must show a 2021-2022 current league recap/standing sheet to verify true average.
- 19. A bowler may not win both bowling balls with high scratch and high handicap series.
- 20. Tournament entry fee: \$60.00 per bowler. Lineage: \$5.00 per game / \$15.00 per bowler, Awards Fee: \$41.00 per bowler, Expense Fee: \$4.00. Promotional Entry Fee: \$15.00: Lineage: \$5.00 per game / \$15.00 per bowler, Awards Fee: \$0.00 per bowler, Expense Fee: \$0.00
- 21. This tournament is **USBC** Certified.
- 22. Errors in scoring must be reported no later than a ½ hour after the tournament completion.
